

RED FLAG WATCH CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

- The Klamath Falls Interagency Fire Center will be responsible for the **RED FLAG WATCH** check in procedure. This procedure will be a safety precaution for all firefighters and fire personnel of current and forecasted weather conditions.
- All on duty fire personnel and engine crews will check in after the fire weather report is transmitted for **RED FLAG WATCHES**.
- All Duty Officers will inform all personnel coming on shift of current and forecasted weather conditions. **RED FLAG WATCHES** will be posted at each district.
- Proper DOCUMENTATION will be done for each and every **RED FLAG WATCH** issued. This document will consist of a resource check-in list utilizing the current daily status information obtained that day.

-Example check-in procedure: "UNITS STAND BY FOR RED FLAG CHECK-IN" (AFTER WEATHER IS TRANSMITTED BY DISPATCH) "102?" (BY DISPATCH) "102 COPIES" OR "102 COPIES AND ALSO 103, 161 WICREW, AND 162 W/CREW" (IF ALL ARE TOGETHER LISTENING)
